- You must have a minimum cumulative or entering GPA of 2.0
- Applications are available in the Student Life and must be returned by Friday, September 12, 2008 for the fall semester and Friday, January 16, 2009 for the winter semester.
- All President's Leadership Academy events and workshops will occur on Tuesdays from 3:00 - 5:00 p.m. You must be able to attend all functions to be considered
- Participants who complete the Academy in good standing will be awarded a \$100 scholarship

The President's Leadership Academy is a semester-long leadership development program for GRCC students sponsored by the President's Office and Student Life. Students who are selected will participate in workshops focused on the 5 Practices of Exemplary Leadership as presented in *The Leadership Challenge* by Barry Posner and James Kouzes.

In addition, students who participate in this academy will also have the opportunity to mentor with a member of GRCC with experience in the area of the participants course of study, and participate in a leadership interview with GRCC President.
